Period 1 April 2015 to 31 March 2016

I declare that the vehicle detailed below was a shared or pool car during the FBT year 1 April 2015 to 31 March 2016, as defined below, and should therefore NOT be a reportable fringe benefit. I have attached the appropriate records to substantiate this declaration.

Definition:

"Pooled or Shared" car: A pooled or shared car is a car that is provided to two or more employees for private use.

For example, if another Senator or Member, or any employee employed under the MOP(S) Act has driven your Private Plated Vehicle (PPV) for **private** purposes, or kept the vehicle at or near their place of residence on one or more occasions during the FBT year commencing 1 April 2015, the provision to you of that PPV will not be a Reportable Fringe Benefit. Similarly, if your PPV was previously allocated to another Senator, Member or MOP(S) Act employee during the FBT year, no Reportable Fringe Benefit arises.
